2025 Oceania & Australian Championship Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron Boat Measurement Procedure

Measurement will be at three stations in the vicinity of the Youth Squad Training Shed (YSTS) - on your right as you enter the club grounds and one station in the Girdis Room (on your left near the sailing office). Items will be checked, and spars, foils and sail marked by the measuring teams. The sequence of measuring is shown below.

Please print your measurement form, available on the regatta website, and bring it with you at all times during measurement for endorsement. Hard copies can be obtained from the sailing office if required.

1. Hull and lines - in front of YSTS

Present dry boat on serviceable dolly with:

- Mast lower section fitted
- Boom fitted at gooseneck
- Mainsheet, outhaul, vang and cunningham fitted
- Rudder and tiller fitted

2. Spars – in YSTS

- Take mast sections and boom to spar station

3. Foils – in YSTS

- Take rudder and centreboard to foil station

4. Sail – in Girdis Room

- Take sail and battens to sail station

Once your form is endorsed at each station you should sign the form indicating that you agree not to change any equipment without permission. Take your completed form to the registration team where it will be retained. Once your registration details are checked and found correct, you are good to go.
